- 2) The students seeking admission to part I should apply to the college office in the prescribed form attached . They should enclose the following certificates along with the prescribed form.
  - a) Original Leaving / Transfer certificate of the School / college last attended and its true copy.
  - b) Original Marklist of the qualifying exam. and it's true copy.
  - c) Original Character certificate issue by the Head of the institution last attended and its true copy.
- 3) Original Character certificate issued by a respectable and responsible person if the student has passed the qualifying exam as an external candidate.
  - a) If the income of the student's guardian is below Rs. 1, 00,000/-, he should submit the application form for fees concession and income certificate along with the net fees payable to the college office.
  - b) The students who have passed the qualifying examination from the Board / University other than M.S. Board of secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune, Amravati University, Amravati will have to pay Rs. 100/- as Migration fee for admission to Amravati University. The Migration certificate of the earlier Board / University should be submitted to the college office up to the 15th of September.
  - c) The students of the other colleges (affiliated to S.G.B. Amravati University) who seek admission to higher class of the college, after having passed the earlier examination, should submit the Original Transfer certificate of the earlier college. If the student seeks mid-session admission to this College he is required to submit the following certificates. - 6) As regards admissions, the final authority rests with the Principal.
- 7) Attendance: In order to be able to appear at the University exam, it is essential that each and every student should have at least 75% attendance in the lectures of every subject. The absentees will be penalized with fine. The fine for absentees for Lectures/practical/ Physical training / Tutorials will be decided by the college competent authority
- 8) Examinations: Apart from University exams the following exams will be conducted by the college. a) Unit Test (First unit test in the first term, second unit test in the second term.) and/or b) First Terminal Exam (Normally in the first week of October). c) Second Terminal Exam (In the month of February). The absentees as well as those who secure less than 20% marks will be penalized with fine. The performance of students in these examinations will be taken into consideration while giving them concessions and aids. The progress of students, their conduct should be up to the level of satisfaction.
- 9) The academic session will commence as per the date declared by the University.
- 10) The duration of the Senior college classes will be from 08:20 am to 5:45 pm.
- 11) All the classes will be conducted regularly and punctually from the commencement of academic Session.
- 13) The college development fund will be utilized for maintenance, security, payment of electrical Charges and so on. These heads of expenditure are non grantable. This fund will be also be utilized for other heads of expenditure for which the government does not provide any grants.
- 14) Medical Checkup: The degree college students will have to undergo medical checkup once a year as a precautionary measure. The absentees during this check up will be penalized.

## Skill Development Based Bachelor of Vocation Graduation Degree Program

With the largest young population in the world the major challenge before our country is to make them employable. It has been a long felt necessity to align higher education with the emerging needs of the economy so as to ensure that the graduates of higher education system have adequate knowledge and skills for employment and entrepreneurship. The higher education system has to incorporate the requirements of various industries in its curriculum, in an innovative and flexible manner to produce holistic and well groomed graduates. Joining hands with National Skill Development Corporation HRD Ministry has come up with a new programme to promote skill development Bachelor of Vocation. The main focus of this degree is to provide hands on training while educating the new generation with the specific aim of making them industry-ready. In keeping with the tradition of being in tune with time, Late Bhaskarrao Shingne Arts, Prof. Narayanrao Gawande Science and Ashalata Gawande Commerce College has introduced vocational three year degree courses viz., Banking & Financial Services, Pharmacy Assistant and Healthcare. The college started these courses from the academic year 2018-2019. These courses are under the NSQF scheme launched by the UGC New Delhi. This is a scheme on skills development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) Degree with multiple exits such as Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF). The B.Voc. Programme is focused on universities and colleges providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOSs along with broad based general education. This would enable the graduates completing B.Voc to make a meaningful participation in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment, becoming entrepreneurs and creating appropriate knowledge..

## Section - 5

### RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION ADMISSION PROCEDURE

#### A) Rules, Regulations and Special Instructions for Students:

- 1) The application form for admission should be carefully filled in any duly furnished with all necessary documents like original Leaving certificate / Transfer certificate, Marklist, Other certificates and adequate fees.
- 2) The fees paid at the time of admission will not, in any case, be refunded if the student wants to leave the college immediately after the admission.
- 3) While the classes are being engaged, the students should not in any way disturb them by roaming aimlessly in the corridors or by talking loudly. They should observe complete silence. In the college premises mobile is not allowed.
- 4) No meetings or programmes should be organized in the college campus without the prior Permission of the Principal.
- 5) No original certificates can be claimed back after admission to college.
- 6) If the student, after he has left college, requires a duplicate copy of the leaving certificate, he will have to submit the affidavit with Rs. 50/- as fees for the same.
- 7) Notices will be pasted / panned on the notice Boards and the students themselves should take note of them. Notices will not be circulated in the class-rooms.
- 8) If the student needs information other than given in the prospectus, he should contact the concerned persons in the college office.
- 9) The student will have to carry his identity card with himself during his presence in the college. He should not enter the college campus without identity card. He is not liable to attend any function in the college, if he cannot produce his identity card on demand.
- 10) The student should carry his identity card with himself while entering the college.
- 11) If the student needs leaving certificate or other certificates, he should write application addressed to the Principal. After fulfilling the necessary conditions, he may get the certificates the next day.
- 12) The student should preserve all receipt of fees paid. They will have to produce these receipts in the office as and when required.
- 13) The student should have 75% attendance in the lectures of all subjects as offered/ tutorials, practicals/ NSS and physical training /Education in order to be able to appear at the Board / University exam. His conduct and progress in Studies should be satisfactory and up to a standard level. If the student remains absent without prior permission he/she will be penalized with fine if the attendance falls below 75% and will not be allowed to appear for University/college examinations .

- 14) The student should be cautious about the regularity in attendance. If he is unable to attend the college on medical grounds, he should write an application to that effect the college office, along with the medical certificate.
- 15) The decisions of the college regarding extracurricular activities will be final and binding to each student.
- 16) The conduct of the student should be such that he should not cause nuisance to others. The cases of misconduct will be seriously dealt with.
- 17) The students should carefully handle the college books, laboratory equipment, lights, fans etc. They should not in any way, cause damage to the college property.
- 18) The students who passes in 1/2 of the subjects to be passed (ignoring fractions) can seek admission to the next higher class, such students who get exemption in some subjects can appear at the university exam. This concession has been granted to students after the march 1986 exam.
- 19) The students seeking admission to final year class of B.A. / B.Com. / B.Sc. should enclose along with their application form, three true copies each of the marks – lists of part I and part II exams.
- 20) Use of Plastic Material, Environmentally non degradable materials without permission, Eating Gutakha, Chewing tobacco and smoking in college campus is strictly prohibited.
- 21) Ragging is strictly Prohibited in college Campus. Anyone who is involved in Ragging directly or indirectly will be punished as per the directives of UGC, Govt. of India, govt. of Maharashtra and SGB Amravati University.
- 22) College is strictly following the Measures for Ensuring the Safety of Women and Programmes for Gender Sensitization on Campuses as per the University Grants Commission (prevention, prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students In higher educational institutions) regulations, 2015 In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of The university grants commission act, 1956 (3 of 1956), sub-section (1) Of section 20 of the said act, College has set up an ICC to look upon in this case.

#### **B. General Information and facilities for Students:**

##### **1) N.S.S. : (200 Seats, Boys - 125, Girls - 75)**

As per the directives of the Govt. of India, some social service schemes are being implemented in this college from 2000 session. Accordingly every student of the college will have to enroll himself in any one of the two scheme viz. N.S.S. (National Service Scheme) or Physical education scheme. If the student's attendance is less than 80% in the

scheme in which he has enrolled himself, he will not be able to appear at the examination.

**2) Library:**

The college has a rich and spacious library of its own. The college students can borrow textual as well as non-textual book from the library for the whole session. There is a provision of special reading room for the students, where they can consult reference books or read various science magazines, general magazines, news papers etc. The rules of lending books and other procedures are displayed the notice board of the library. The working hours of the library are from 7:30 am to 5:50 pm. The students should observe silence in the library.

**3) Games and Sports Contests:**

The students are always encouraged to participate in various games and sports contests and competitions. The students have facilities to take part in games like Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Badminton, Volleyball, Cricket etc. The college participates in the annual university level events of games and sports. The talented students are always encouraged. In this regard, the students should contact the Physical education teacher from time to time.

**4) Remedial Courses for educationally backward students :**

The educationally backward students of B.A.I, B.Sc. I and B.Com I classes are enlisted are extra coaching is imparted to them in order to enhance their educational level. The S.C. and S.T. students are especially included in this list of backward students.

**5) Vehicle Stand / Parking :**

There is a special vehicle stand for college students to park their vehicles. The students parking their vehicles in no-parking zones will be fined / penalized.

**6) Guardian - Student Meet:**

Every year guardians and parents of students are invited to college on a certain date. It is a sort of Annual Social Gathering of the guardians and students, in which the guardians freely give suggestions for the betterment of the institution.

**7) Wall Magazine:**

The wall magazine is a special feature of the creative activities of the students. It is a medium used by the students to give vent to their talents in Arts, (Such as Drawing / Painting) and literary activities.

**8) Intercollegiate Competitions :**

Various intercollegiate competitions (Such as elocution competition, essay writing

competition etc.) are organized in the college from time to time.

**9) Information, Guidance and Counseling Cell :**

This cell (Centre) is run in the college under the auspices of Amravati University. This centre provides to the students information regarding higher education, various competitive examinations, personality development etc.

**10) Educational Tours:**

Educational tours for college students are arranged every year.

**11) Extra Curricular Activities:**

There will be no annual social gathering in lieu of it, various extracurricular activities are undertaken through subject societies and associations, Literary Societies, games and sports committee etc. They provide opportunities to exhibit their talents.

**12) Dress Code/Uniform :**

The college has dress code for the staff and students.

**13) Daily monitoring in Campus :**

College has established a monitoring committee consisting of teachers and non teaching staff to check out Trespassers and to ensure smooth running of the college.

**14) Network Resource Centre (NRC) :**

The College has Network Resource Centre (NRC) with computers and internet facility in the Library and Computer Lab.

**15) Botanical Garden :**

A small but useful botanical garden is available for the student of botany and others for study, consisting of variety of plants.

**16) Girls' Common Room :**

Girls' Common Room is present in the campus with basic needs.

**17) Student Grievance Redressal Cell :**

General Grievance of the Students is solved in this cell. A special cell is established to rectify the complaints of the students.

**18) Suggestion Box :**

Suggestion box is placed in the college premises near the office. Proper and positive suggestions are invited from the students to improve the status of the college.

**19) Complaint Box :**

Complaint box is placed in the college premises near the Principal office.
